

# DUI-LEG og VIRKE

## Jubi-lejr 2005

Hals 16-24 juli



It is now time to send in the preliminary enrolment form for our Jubilee camp 2005 to the National Office of DUI-LEG og VIRKE. Deadline is 31 December 2004.

Four working groups have slowly been working towards the goal so that everything can be ready for the 16<sup>th</sup> of July. The technical group has been working hard to make portable bathrooms and toilets ready for use, the activity group has held meetings on which activities that shall be at the camp and, the kitchen group has also held a meeting to discuss the meals on the camp.

### OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATION:



The camp will be a tent camp, and the local branches/ international guests must bring along their own tents that are necessary to accommodate the number of people from the branch. It will also be possible to bring a caravan. Further guidelines for the caravans and for the possibility of connecting electricity will hopefully be clarified in January. It will also be clarified if there is a possibility to rent a room on the continuation school.

### CAMP VILLAGES:

The camp will be divided into villages with about 100-200 participants in each village. The international participants, who we are expecting a lot of, will be spread out on all the villages.

### TRANSPORT:

The participants pay the transport to a Danish port or airport, and DUI-LEG og VIRKE will provide the transport in Denmark.

**AKTIVITIES:**

We are working intensively on making a really good programme for the camp. The programme will in many ways be different from recent years. We will be working with a number of theme days, and only a few of the activities will last throughout the entire camp period. It is formed in a way that all branches/international organisations shall contribute to the theme days. The international organisations mainly the International day, but are also welcome to help with other theme days. Which activity they want to be responsible for/help with must be notified to DUI-LEG og VIRKE's National office not later than the final enrolment.

Everyone must participate in the carrying through of 1-2 theme days, whilst you can enjoy the theme days of the other branches/countries the remaining days.

We are considering the activities mentioned below to be carried through (with reservation of changes):

**Opening- and closing ceremony**

**Childrens tent** - morning and afternoon, there will be paper and pen and crayons / picture books / toys (computer games, board games etc.) / playing blankets / mattresses / fruit and biscuits.

**Grown up tent** - open from 10 a.m. -12 p.m. and 2 - 5 p.m. There will be coffee and tea so you can sit and relax. Every day from 3 p.m. there will be a political café where the leaders can get some inspiration, both professionally, pedagogical, political and organisationally.



**Media - Newspaper:** will be written by the children and youths. Furthermore the Villages have to make daily reports on the camp life of the village. **Television:** The local DUI's-TV-Falken will be at the camp, and the children and youths will go around the camp and film the everyday camp life. There will be produced small clips every day that will be available on the Internet for downloading. **Web:** In addition to the small video clips the Internet will be the window to those at home, where they can see what is going on.

**International seminar** - We are working on organising an international seminar primarily for the foreign participants in the time before the Jubilee camp. We are currently putting together a programme and we are making an application for this purpose to different funds.

**THEME DAYS:**

- **Village day** - where the villages are being started. As the villages get a name there will be provided a breeding ground for flags, songs about the village and urban design. A village gate must be made. The village will get established, including the making of a place for a bonfire. Furthermore there will be different social initiatives: the inhabitants of the cities will get to know each other this day.



- **Workshop day** - with wood workshop /fabric printing, camp printing and special bags (rucksack) / pearls and jewellery / yarn / ice cubes made of stone / soap- and candle making / paintings (frames of plaster) / boxes with things from the nature (shells, twigs and stones).

- **Nature day** - there will be a guided tour in the nature with a ranger. Here you can look at birds, bugs, animals and of course the nature itself. We will be using binoculars and magnifying glasses. It will be for all ages and later you can use the things you collect in the nature for e.g. decorations, bracelets of apple pips and earrings of leaf. We will also be going out sailing.

- **International day** - Morning: Decoration and setting up of the market place. Afternoon: Market with stalls, activities and performances. Evening: International event with performances and music.



- **Olympic day** - In every village you can choose between different competitions in which the villages then will compete.

- **Excursion day** - There will be one free excursion, but if one should not like to participate in this particular excursion there will be the possibility of - on payment of - going somewhere else. E.g. Faarup Sommerland (Amusement park), Aalborg Tivoli or likewise. The branches/international organisations will have to pay the entry fees at these places, but the transport to and from these places is free of charge.

**DUI 1905 day** - here we will be looking back at the year 1905 and in many ways relate to past times. The food served this day will e.g. be based on what people used to eat when you went on a camp in the beginning of the last century.

We encourage the participants to bring clothes relating to that time and suitable to wear that day.



**MEALS:**

There will be three meals each day: Breakfast / lunch / dinner.

Participants will not be in charge of the cooking, and most meals are expected to be eaten some place central in the camp.

**CAMP ACTIVISTS:** During the camp there will be a number of activists, who are responsible for e.g. the technical facilities. These activists will also be consciousness-raisin group for e.g. the camp activities and the kitchen, but all the participants, youngsters as well as grown-ups will however have to help out with e.g. practical assignments in the kitchen, cleaning of showers and toilets and so on during the camp.

**PARTICIPANT FEE:** The cost of the camp is DKR. 1.200,-, however children under the age of four are free.  
The price includes all meals, activities, one excursion and transport to and from port/Airport to the camp.
